THE PLANNING OF A SEA CONTAINER Richard Renfro, Board of Trustees Vice-President

This article is a look at the planning that Mission Printing generally does before we set up a destination to ship sea containers. Tom Garner, our president, Vendall Dollarhide, our director, Mary Carroll, our office manager, and I usually discuss the pros and cons of an ocean container's destination. We consider the area of the greatest need for Mission Printing material and search for a good volunteer distribution manager in that country.

I try to make a fact-finding trip to the area and visit the potential manager before we make a commitment to ship the containers. I was in Cape Town, South Africa, on a ten-day trip to visit with potential distribution managers for that part of Africa. God has blessed me with interested brethren who have given me free tickets (frequent flyer miles) to aid in my travels. I had several meetings, one with more than twenty congregational leaders. Bro. Rohan Jones and Bro. Paul Gerber had planned a busy agenda for me. This June, twenty Christian volunteers from the U.S. are expected to help in a campaign of door-knocking and distribution of our tracts. It is important that Mission Printing can deliver a container of tracts on time to help in the Cape Town campaign.

Distribution managers are the key to foreign distribution. of our sea container shipments of more than 800,000 tracts. We choose them by their ability to reach thousands of contacts and hundreds of congregations who can help them distribute the material. They must also provide a storage area that is safe from fire, flood, vandalism, and theft. Managers must be willing to make access to the stored material for those requesting in their area. They distribute the material to congregations, seminars, preaching schools, youth gatherings, lectureships, ministers, missionaries, Bible class teachers and

Interested individuals. Mission Printing pays for the shipment until the container arrives at the manager's storage area. Then they distribute it, sometimes at their own expense. We do not ask them to spend their money on distribution, but only require that the material be made available. Mission Printing requests managers to send pictures and emails about the success they are having with the tracts to encourage our contributors and volunteers. We are so grateful for the dedicated distribution managers who are making this program so successful.

Another ingredient of success in shipping tracts via sea container is the forwarding company and the clearing agent. God has blessed me with the ability to complete all the shipping instructions and the U.S. Government forms as well as the foreign country forms required to make a successful delivery. Missionary Expeditors delivers a container to our door, and we load it with as many as one thousand boxes of material. They then deliver it to the port of destination in the foreign country. The clearing agent must be a trusted and experienced individual who can complete all the complicated forms and comply with all the various regulations of each country for custom clearance.

The door to door shipment cost is generally \$10,000 instead of the \$120,000-\$130,000 via U.S. Mail. We plan to ship another container to Nigeria on February 19. That will make four container shipments in the last 15 months by Mission Printing.

God is blessing Mission Printing, and we pray that He will continue to bless us in the future. Will you join us in spreading God's Word throughout the world? With your support and prayers, we can read the hungry souls!
